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□ CLOTHES AND OUTFITS

Plan swimsuits and towels for all participants. The beds are made before your arrival, you do not need to bring sheets. To give you the choice, all the beds of your ecolodge will be made, please use only the beds according to the number of occupants.

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□ THE CUTLERY

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You can add to your stay "local food at the ecolodge" in extra : gourmet diner, bistronomic hamper and aperitif hamper for the evening. Snack and fast food restauration are available for lunch at the bar-café-boutique of the estate. The necessary cutlery is provided with our options. If you want to eat on your own, remember to bring your dishes (glasses, cutlery, plates, corkscrew...).



Some of our unusual accommodations are equipped with a microwave and a mini-fridge, you can consult the equipment of your accommodation directly on our website.
